The Centre for Competition Law & Policy has been recently **granted the honor** to become the **first research Centre in the country on Competition Law**, established at any National Law University in India, **to get the prestigious recognition as partner institution from United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD) at its Research Partnership Platform (RPP).**

UNCTAD is the specialized agency of United Nations dealing with the issues of Competition Law & Policy at International Platform. UNCTAD RPP is a unique initiative which brings together institutions, universities and competition authorities to undertake joint research and deliberations on the issues and challenges in the area of competition law and policy. The RPP is an initiative that aims to advance state-of-the-art formulation and enforcement of competition and consumer protection laws and policies for better development, and to offer a flexible, consultative environment for solving the most challenging problems on competition and consumer protection laws and policies, particularly in developing countries and economies in transition.

Being a member of RPP at UNCTAD the Centre would be, in future, eligible for drafting specialized project proposals on the Competition Policy for which even funding can be provided by UNCTAD. Apart from this, we would be invited for participating in Annual Meeting of RPP at UNCTAD which takes place in Geneva every year.

i Articles, which analyze topics of permanent interest from major national

jurisdictions as well as contemporary international issues on competition law and policy (5,000-10,000 words including footnotes)

- i. Short Notes, which cover topical recent developments in competition law (2,000-5,000 words including footnotes)
- ii. Case Comments on recent or landmark cases, suggesting a change in policy or interpretation, related to competition law (1,500- 2,000 words including footnotes)

ICLR is pleased to announce its upcoming issue, Volume 2, which is to be published in February, 2017. **The deadline for submission of manuscripts for the forthcoming issue has been extended to October 15, 2016.** However, ICLR accepts manuscripts year-round and any manuscript submitted after the aforesaid deadline will be considered for publication in the next issue i.e.

Volume 3. ICLR is also in the process of acquiring ISSN, which in all probability would be received by the end of October, 2016.
